This transducer must be used in electric/electronic equipment with respect to applicable standards and safety requirements in accordance with the manufacturer's operating instructions.




Caution, risk of electrical shock

When operating the transducer, certain parts of the module can carry hazardous voltage (eg. primary busbar, power supply). Ignoring this warning can lead to injury and/or cause serious damage.

This transducer is a build-in device, whose conducting parts must be inaccessible after installation. A protective housing or additional shield could be used. Main supply must be able to be disconnected.

## **Mechanical characteristics**

- General tolerance
- Fastening & connection of primary Recommended PCB hole
- Fastening & connection of secondary Recommended PCB hole
- ±0.2 mm 8 pins 1.4 × 1 mm 2 mm
- 3 pins 0.7 × 0.6 mm
- 1.2 mm

### Remarks

- The temperature of the primary circuit board trace connected to the primrary pins of the transducer should not exceed 100 °C during operation.
- $I_{\rm s}$  is positive when  $I_{\rm p}$  flows in the direction of the arrow.
