Housing for RAFIX 22 FS Control Components



The RAFIX 22 FS E-Box is an elegant, extremely well-designed housing for control components. It can be used wherever individual control component units are required in remote places. Very typical, for example, for Emergency-Stop applications along a production line or on the safety fence.

The dimensions of the RAFIX 22 FS E-BOX and also the assembly concept are based on the edge dimension of a 40 mm profile rail.

Simple assembly concept, based on 40 mm profile rails



- Insert metal clip in profile rail slot (locating noses on the clip ensure precise adjustment, fix with only one screw)
- The metal clip can also be screwed onto other surfaces.



- Mount housing bottom part
- Attach contact module
- Insert the wires
- Connect the terminals




- Insert RAFIX 22 FS actuator (e.g. Emergency-Stop) into housing top part
- Fix actuator with a ring nut



Snap housing top part onto bottom part. Done!

Housing

- Extremely compact (dimensions 109 x 40 x 27 mm)
- Suitable for actuators from the RAFIX 22 FS control unit range (ø 22.3 mm)
- With yellow housing cap for Emergency-Stop actuator
- With grey housing cap for standard actuators (such as pushbuttons)
- Fixing
 - with the timesaving one-hole screw attachment method, particularly suitable for aluminium profile rails
 - or alternatively by direct attachment with M4 screws
- Includes cable lead-in for direct cabling







E-Box application examples



Profile rails are widely used in machinery and plant, as they can be universally deployed in all kinds of stable structures. They are used in, among other areas, logistics and production, because they can cover large span lengths. Aluminium profile rails are also widely used in the chassis structure of assembly robotics, for CNC machines or automatic injection moulding machines, as well as in transport and conveyor systems. Industrial work and test benches are most often built using profile rails.

Certain profile designs in this world-wide range of structures are also suitable for safety fences. Depending on the profile, various different panes or wave mesh can be used.

The range of accessories for profile rails is generally very extensive and suitable for all kinds of applications.

The E-Box assembly concept is based on profile rails. However, the E-Box can also be mounted on other surfaces. You can use the metal clip, or screws for direct mounting, to attach the E-Box to cast iron, wood, plaster, concrete, and many other surfaces.
